1. Funding plan for COBA's budget cut

Stephanie Bryant

- a. Budget cut is less than originally anticipated
 - i. Higher administration reduced COBA's cut from \$469,038.09 to \$375,731.80
- b. Numbers were reviewed for COBA's cost of the mid-year raise and amounts COBA has available in salary savings
- c. A motion by Jim Lampe was adopted that the cost of \$375,731.80 would be paid from COBA's salary savings funds.
 - i. The COBA Budget Committee unanimously agreed

2. Supplemental course fee

Stephanie Bryant

- a. Dean Bryant and a student representative will present to the Board of Governors this Friday, February 17th
 - i. Several students have expressed their support
- b. Fees would benefit COBA students and their success
 - i. Capital improvements (85%)
 - ii. Student Success Center (will also raise private funds for this)
 - iii. Student Scholarships/Study Abroad
 - iv. Student Organizations (5%)
- 3. Other
 - a. Executive Budget Committee updates

Steve Parker

- i. Tuition increase based on the recent budget cut
 - 1. 3.2% increase to in-state undergraduate
 - 2. 6.1% increase to in-state graduate
 - 3. 6.1% increase to out-of-state undergraduate
 - 4. 6.61% increase to out-of-state graduate
- b. Administrative salaries policy

Stephanie Bryant

- i. 9/11^{ths} policy is no longer in effect for when administrators retreat to faculty
 - 1. All COBA Department Heads will have new letters written
- c. Faculty Senate Proposal

Steve Parker

- i. Cost of raising faculty salaries to 100% of the CUPA median
 - 1. COBA faculty would not benefit from this much
 - 2. COBA is an AACSB accredited school and needs to be compared to other AACSB schools, not CUPA
