1. Status of Budget Cuts

Stephanie Bryant

- a. General recommendation of committee is to not cut existing positions if possible.
- b. Scenario One
 - *i.* Don't change internet \$55 academic affairs cut 1.2 million; COB share \$227,127
 - 1. Recommendations from Committee: take from open lines and salary savings

Summary for Scenario One:

1 Faculty line + SS

\$130.000 line \$46,800 fringe \$176.800 +50,200 Salary Savings \$227,000

- c. Scenario Two
 - i. Change internet from \$55 to \$40; COB share \$92,962
 - 1. Recommendations from Committee: cut a line (tenure track) plus freeze a line for next year (as a hedge)
- d. 1.2% cut evenly spread across Colleges
- e. Executive Budget Committee meets on 4/27
- f. COB representatives on Academic Affairs Committee: Barry Cobb and Sandy Byrd; COB representative on EBC: Richard Gebken

Summary for Scenario Two:

\$130,000 line \$93,000 cut 37,000 added to salary savings for next year 13,000 fringe to be transferred \$50,000 salary savings generated

- Freeze a line as a hedge against a cut next year
- 2. Open Positions
 - a. ACC: 2 open; 1 retirement (Harsha); 2 pending retirement next year
 - b. FGB: 1 open; 1 retirement (Scott)
 - 1. Identified how to fund position for two years

- *ii.* Baker Chair hired Prakash
- c. MKT: 1 retirement (Karrupan)
- d. CIS: 1 cybersecurity; 1 retirement (Hignite)
- e. MGT: DH line converted to a faculty line; 1 retirement (Dale)
- f. TCM: 1 open
- 3. Salary Savings \$156,000 in unallocated
 - a. Previous Budget Committee recommendation was to retain one position in Salary Savings
- 4. Operating Budget one time money
 - a. 4.4 added to base budget last year
- 5. Equity Adjustments
 - a. Committee agreed none this year would be prudent
- 6. General Committee Concerns / Discussions with reduced faculty
 - a. FTE
 - b. Course coverage
 - c. Class size / Enrollment
 - d. Curriculum Reviews imperative
- 7. Subsequent Action of Committee (email vote) Results (April 20, 2017)
 - a. The vote of the subsequent COB Budget Committee was 9-1 in favor of scenario 2 (changing internet incentive to \$40/head). One committee member abstained.
