- FGB, MGT, MKT and COB Computing. Funds in excess of the \$397,783 reduction will go into COB salary savings.
- ix. Cancellation of Spring Break Study Away Programs The cancellation of Spring Break Study Away programs will have a significant impact on students needing credit hours for graduation, financial aid, etc. Be as accommodating as possible, within University policy, in assisting students make up the lost SA credits. If a student decides to drop out of the study away program before the end of the semester, they will be reimbursed their tuition.
- x. IDEA Feedback & Annual Reports Stef handed out the IDEA packets. DHs will address takeaways in their annual reports and are encouraged to discuss areas of concern with Dean Meinert.
- xi. Coronavirus Update Dean Meinert will send a message to the faculty re plans for all MSU courses to go online for at least 2 weeks following Spring Break. The MSU Coronavirus Task Force will be meeting tomorrow to figure out the trickle-down-effect this will have on the University. CLT was encouraged to send Dean Meinert questions or concerns for the Task Force in advance of this meeting. Blackboard shells for all courses will be created in the coming days. GAs & Student Workers can still work at the direction of the DHs. When seated classes resume, students with health concerns will need to go through proper channels for an accommodation. The same will be true for COB Faculty & Staff with health issues who are concerned about being on-campus. Dean Meinert recommended all BAC advisors acquire a ZOOM account to support virtual advising sessions.
