- i. Exclusivity Rule for UGCT Graduate level is 40% of the hours taken, but there is not a rule at the UG level. Would have to work through Faculty Senate to get a rule set. Jeff Jones is willing to put together a proposal to create but needs guidance. Dave will bring up at next Dean's Council.
- ii. FA21 Blackboard Shells will include U. Academic Policy Statement This will ensure that all faculty/courses are directing students to the most current policies. This will be more efficient for faculty and students.

- iii. SU21 Enrollments Summer numbers are down at the moment but there are still 700+ students who haven't registered for Fall. Summer numbers could still go up.
- iv. FA21 Enrollments We are at approximately 7500+ students enrolled currently as opposed to 8500+ last year. Early indicators suggest there is still an opportunity for MSU to return to pre-COVID enrollment levels for FA21.
