Themes for 2013-14:

Continue strong emphasis on attracting and retaining the best and brightest students to MSU, including transfer students, students from star high schools in Missouri, and students from outside Missouri (with emphasis on California, Texas, and Illinois) to achieve targeted growth in our signature programs. The development and implementation of an effective marketing and branding plan is central to this goal.

Review and revise our COB Core Curriculum, and the MBA curriculum.

Goal 5: Support and reward personal excellence and professional development in faculty and staff.

Themes for 2013-14:

Align summer research grant amounts with new AACSB standards to incentivize discipline-based research.

Summer research grants - \$750/\$250 split between basic research and pedagogical/applied research

2 New Research Fellowships - \$5,000; awarded annually based on prior year research quality and cumulative research productivity of high quality research — emphasis on discipline based basic research
