 - a. Departments can give as many awards as they wish, and can create new awards or discontinue awards they don't have to be the same each year.
 - b. If a cash award is attached to a Department Award, the Department pays for that from their Foundation funds
 - 2. Dean and Associate Deans make Delp and Cheek final decisions from DH nominations and student essays
 - a. Essays should be submitted with M# only no name
 - ii. Golden Bear Award
 - 1. CLT nominations due by next meeting. Dean makes final decision.
 - iii. Sandy will provide a list of graduating students from SU15 and FA15 and SP16, for selection of student to carry COB banner.
 - iv. COB Commencement speaker we will nominate our departmental and COB award nominees (above)
