- Salary Savings (unallocated salary)
  - Approximately one tenure track position w/ fringe
- The Opportunity Cost of Increasing Open Lines to Market Rates
  - At least \$279,140 in salary savings expended since 2014/2015
- One Time Monies will not be replenishing at past rates
- UG Fee Monies
  - Going forward 50/50 split with the President after debt obligation
  - Expanded to 200 level courses effective FA18


