



Programs within the business unit in the College of Business are fully accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business, or AACSB.

Among global colleges and universities offering business degrees only 2 percent have AACSB accreditation and supplemental accounting accreditation.



Programs that maintain AACSB accreditation include: School of Accountancy: finance. economics and risk management information technology and cybersecurity; management; and marketing. Bachelor of Science degrees in construction management, mechanical engineering technology and Master of Science in project management maintain accreditations not associated with AACSB. as they are not eligible for AACSB accreditation.
